Portakabin: Lean Production at Portakabin Lesson plan

Content area

- Lean Production
- Just-in-time
- Quality management
- Kaizen

Method

This resource can be used for general classwork, homework or learning skills for investigation.

It is a good simple exercise in bringing the various terminologies together in understanding what it means, and how it can be used in context. This allows the pupils to bring out more in discussion and understand that the topics covered in Business Studies are not insular. The outcome will be by differentiation.

First Activity:

Using the case study and any other resources, define the following words: Sales turnover; :LTD; employer; employee; trademark; patent; copyrightqproduct; market orientated; product orientated; modular; job production; batch production; flow production; cellular production; logistics; quality assurance; total quality management; lean production; resources; aims; objectives; quality management system; kaizen; kanban; innovation; ISO9001; regulations; social costs; social benefits; private costs; private benefits; just-in-time; added value; working capital; cash flow; storage; stock control; workforce planning; capacity utilisation; landfill; off site manufacturing; sub contracting; in house; supply chain; environment; corporate social responsibility; lead time; buffer stock; contingency planning; recycling; stakeholders; critical path analysis.

Second Activity

Once you have completed the definitions link the following words together to form a paragraph. The words do not necessarily have to be in any order but must be in context of Portakabin.
