Answers to questions

 What is a stakeholder?
A stakeholder is an individual or group with an interest in the decisions of a business. Stakeholders can affect, or be affected, by an organisation.

- 2. Give examples of some of Primark's external stakeholders. Primark's external stakeholders include:
 - Customers
 - Governments
 - Trade unions and civil society groups
 - Workers and communities



3. Explain the objectives of the trade unions and civil society groups with which Primark works.

The goals of these organisations are involved in protecting the rights of workers e.g. by ensuring they are paid a decent wage, do not use child labour, have a limit to the working hours they can carry out and have proper leave entitlements.

4. Analyse why providing information about Primark's ethical behaviour is important for the future of the firm.

Providing information about ethical behaviour is important because:

- Without customers businesses cannot exist
- Primark relies on word-of-mouth advertising from one customer to another
- Customers have concerns over the behaviour of organisations and may base their purchasing decisions on these.
